I. Admission information

1. Grade and major for enrollment

(1) Grade I Sem 1, Grade II Sem 1, Grade III Sem 1

Chinese Language (research orientation: Business Chinese)

Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (research orientations: ① Chinese Language Education; ② Chinese Language & Culture)

(2) Grade I Sem 2, Grade II Sem 2

Chinese Language (research orientations: ① Business Chinese; ② Tourism Culture)

2. Fee: (1) Application fee: RMB 520

(2) Tuition fee: RMB 18,000/year (Grade I & II); RMB 19,800/year (Grade III & IV)

II. Qualifications

1. Aged 16 years or above, in good health conditions; Non-Chinese citizen: as required by *the Document No. 12 (2020) of Ministry of Education of the PRC*;

2. With certificate of senior high school or above (paper documents should be offered);

3. Take the China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA) tests for Chinese and Mathematics.

Applicants for the Chinese Language major with the valid HSK 4 test report are exempt from the Chinese subject test. When applying to our university, applicants must submit their CSCA test results.

4. With the following requirements according to different grades:

(1) Grade I (Sem 1)

New students should pass the Entrance Examination of Grade I (Sem 1).

Note: Students should get the certificate and transcript of HSK 4 (score over 210) before go up to Grade II. Otherwise they are not qualified to go up to Grade II.

(2) Grade I (Sem 2)

i. Students plan to begin their studies starting from Grade I (Sem 2) should: ① offer the certificate and transcript of one semester's study (20 credits) provided by a university or a college; ② offer the certificate and transcript of HSK 4 (score over 180); ③ pass the Entrance Examination of Grade I (Sem 2).

ii. Audit students of Grade I (Sem 2) should: offer the certificate and transcript of one semester's study (20 credits) provided by a university or a college.

Note: After studying one semester as language students, pass the Entrance Examination of Grade II (Sem 1) and offer the certificate and transcript of HSK 4 (score over 210).

(3) Grade II (Sem 1)

i. Students plan to begin their studies starting from Grade II (Sem 1) should: ① offer the certificate and

transcript of two semesters' study (40 credits) provided by a university or a college; ② offer the certificate and transcript of HSK 4 (score over 210); ③ pass the Entrance Examination of Grade II (Sem 1).

ii. Audit students of Grade II (Sem 1) should: ① offer the certificate and transcript of two semesters' study (40 credits) provided by a university or a college; ② offer the certificate and transcript of HSK 4 (score over 195).

Note: After studying one semester as language students, pass the Entrance Examination of Grade II (Sem 2) and offer the certificate and transcript of HSK 4 (score over 210).

(4) Grade II (Sem 2)

i. Students plan to begin their studies starting from Grade II (Sem 2) should: ① offer the certificate and transcript of three semesters' study (60 credits) provided by a university or a college; ② offer the certificate and transcript of HSK 4 (score over 210); ③ pass the Entrance Examination of Grade II (Sem 2).

ii. Audit students of Grade II (Sem 2) should: ① offer the certificate and transcript of three semesters' study (60 credits) provided by a university or a college; ② offer the certificate and transcript of HSK 4 (score over 195).

Note: After studying one semester as language students, pass the Entrance Examination of Grade III (Sem 1) and offer the certificate and transcript of HSK 5 (score over 180).

(5) Grade III (Sem 1)

Students plan to begin their studies starting from Grade III (Sem 1) should: ① offer the certificate and transcript of four semesters' study (80 credits) provided by a university or a college; ② offer the certificate and transcript of HSK 5 (score over 180); ③ pass the Entrance Examination of Grade III (Sem 1).

IV. CSCA Mathematics Tutoring Class and HSK Tutoring Class

1. The college offers a CSCA Mathematics tutoring class each semester. Students who successfully enroll in the undergraduate program of the International College of Chinese Studies will have their tutoring fees refunded.
